PCE Training Outlines

1. Education as an Introduction to Total Reality

The training, *Education as Introduction to Total Reality*, introduces the trainees to the meaning of Education: the process of accompanying the young to discover themselves and the reality around them through the tradition they have received. The training helps the teachers to understand that the educator is the one that guides the young to maturity by being a provocation to them to personally verify what they face every day.

TARGET BENEFICIARIES; Teachers, tutors, instructors

2. The Value of the Person and Psychosocial Support

The course highlights the major characteristics of the human being – his heart's desires (for beauty, love, truth, justice and happiness) and his use of reason (in achieving these desires). This training explores the value of the person and where it lies. Participants are helped to discover that the person's value lies in his/her link with the Mystery and is not dependent on circumstances (good or bad).

TARGET BENEFICIARIES; Teachers, school administrators, parents and social workers involved in educational activities.

3. The Educative Role of Parents

The training, structured in 1 session develops the content of education in specific reference to the educative task of the family. The training aims at developing in the parents, the awareness that education is the most natural expression of love for their children.

TARGET BENEFICIARIES; Parents, Guardians and care givers.

4. Medical work and the Person

This training focuses on the value of the person in the patient and fellow medical workers. Participants are helped to strengthen the human position in front of the patient, whichever conditions he or she is facing.

TARGET BENEFICIARIES; All staff of medical institutions like Doctors, nurses, laboratory attendants, counselors, cleaners, gate keepers, gardeners and receptionists.

5. <u>Vocational Skills Educative Companionship</u>

This training is designed for local artisans, who host students from vocational training institutions during industrial placements. The seminar presents a provocation on the educative responsibility of these enterprise owners, beyond providing practical skills during apprenticeship programmes.

TARGET BENEFICIARIES; Local artisans engaging in skill based apprenticeship programs.

6. Introduction to innovational entrepreneurship and Group Dynamics

This training on Entrepreneurship planning and Management is tailored for youth that are completing their vocational studies or involved in operating and overseeing Income Generating Activities (IGA). There is an entrepreneurial skills gap in most of the existing efforts to uplift household incomes.

The training encompasses an introduction to Innovative Entrepreneurship, the business plan as an essential tool, and sustaining Competitiveness as a young business owner.

TARGET BENEFICIARIES; Students enrolled in vocational institutions and seeking to set up IGAs.

7. Youth Education For HIV Prevention

This training module helps the youths discover their role in the fight against the spread of HIV/AIDS. It urges them to reflect on the place of reason and authoritative companionship in the fight against HIV, especially in verifying the proposals offered by adults and peers.

Participants are helped to understand that every person's desires (for instance Happiness, Love, Beauty, Justice and Truth) can be directed to the recognition and preservation of the dignity and value of her/himself and the others. Some of the preventive areas emphasized in the workshops include: an experiential understanding of the place of education in HIV Prevention, verification of sexual proposals, culture and tradition, how to appreciate the role of authoritative companionship and personal responsibility in the sustenance of our value towards an HIV free world.

TARGET BENEFICIARIES; Adolescents and young adults.

8. Peace And Reconciliation For Youth

Our training course on *Peace and Reconciliation* is designed as a follow-up tool that provides the youth with continued reflection on the importance of justice in social cohesion.

It depicts the significance of tradition, educative companionship and personal verification in peace building and winds up with the revelation that Peace is the ultimate freedom to humanity.

TARGET BENEFICIARIES; Adolescents and young adults.

9. <u>Computer Literacy Training</u>

The training is structured to equip the learner with basic skills in Microsoft Office Packages. The method aims at giving the learners practical skills on how to use a personal computer. The training is structured in such a way that each learner has got plenty of time for practising directly, with the help of the facilitators.

TARGET BENEFICIARIES; Students and adults.
